Category Explanation

Picture Making- Telling a story through pictures. Please use specified medium for that category.

Creative Design- Any artwork using the specified media type.

Seasonal Articles- Examples: Christmas picture, Easter Craft, Mother's Day Arrangement, Canada Day, New Year's, Father's Day or Remembrance Day Artwork.

Computer Graphic Design- This may be a design created using a computer program and printed off. Please mount on poster paper.

Penmanship Special- **See example in this booklet

- Each entry should be on one side of loose leaf or foolscap **and mounted** on colored paper.
- Kindergarten to Grade 3 must be in pencil. Grade 4-6 must be in blue or black ink.
- Kindergarten to Grade 2 must be printed. Grade 3-6 must be in cursive writing.
- Grade level must be marked on TOP RIGHT CORNER and entry tag stapled to bottom right corner.
- Entries are judged on neatness and form only
- Entry must include
 - a) Alphabet in upper and lowercase letters
 - b) Numbers 0-9
 - c) Remainder of the page should be filled with prose or poetry (Except Kindergarten)

RULES

- ☐ **No more than one entry is allowed per exhibitor category. You may enter in categories in grades above but not below.**
- ☐ **Entries must have been created within the last year by the exhibitor and may have been made at home, school or clubs.**
- ☐ **We value your artwork and will strive to maintain its condition, however, the Committee is not responsible for any damages that may occur**
- ☐ **IF YOUR NAME IS VISIBLE ON YOUR EXHIBIT, IT MUST BE COVERED OR TAPED OVER OR ENTRY WILL BE CONSIDERED VOID.**
- ☐ **No brand names of products may be on any exhibits.**
- ☐ **All entry tags are to be filled out by the exhibitor and stapled or taped to LOWER RIGHT CORNER of exhibit. Your Exhibitor # will be given to you at the time of exhibit entry.**
- ☐ **Neatness, originality and general appearance will all be taken into account for placing Awards.**

PRIZES

All prizes for Schoolwork Exhibits will be paid in cash and can be collected at the Fair Office (green building across from the South end of the Main Grand Stand) from Wednesday through Sunday of Stampede. All prize winners must sign for their prize. Prize money not claimed by September 7, 2018 will be forfeited.
