BuckAroo ROPER is a competition developed for the youth in the exhibition sport of Team Roping. The BuckAroo Roper competition is scheduled in the Grandstand during the Pro- Rodeo Shows on a DUMMY steer head.



BuckAroo Roper Rules- BuckAroo Roper - Rules and Regulations will be followed. Please comply with the requests and suggestions of the volunteer(s) of the event

Registration and Demonstration of the roping will ensure the Buckaroo roper has the best opportunity to compete at the Rodeo Grandstand competition is mandatory.

_____-BuckAroo parents/guardians are invited to watch, but not participate

<u>Practise /Competition Day- check in</u> will be at the <u>Big Steel Box</u> on the Fair grounds at 4 pm on Thurs/Fri and 12pm Sat/Sun prior to the Demo and Practise — approximately one hourance time to practise

-Demonstration is provided by the CPRA Roping Cowboys —with a 3 round (loop) performance round practise will be provided in the fair area for each contestant

Grandstand Event Day -Please meet outside the Fair Office - 15 minutes prior to the show (Thurs/Fri - 6:45 pm or Sat/Sun - 1:45 pm)

IMPORTANT NOTE: Purchase of tickets to the Grandstand Rodeo is mandatory to compete- show proof at registration

- 1. BuckAroo Competitors age- 8-12 years old as of the date of entry
- 2. Proof of age will be requested at registration/demonstration(ie Manitoba Healthcare Card)
- 3. Six -6 competitors per day- maximum with 3 alternates- alternate may not be able to rope in the Grandstand competition
- 4. Practise will consist of a successful one (loop) round- for each contestant.
- 5. May bring your own rope or own gloves but not required to compete ropes will be available and calf dummy.
- 6. Line will be marked and the Roping Contest will begin; For Grandstand show there is 2 loop attempts and if the contestant catches on the first ATTEMPT no further attempts are required.
- 7. If no successful catches in the first 2 attempts; a 1 loop attempt round will allowed for each contestant
- 8. FINAL SCORE includes the ability to have one legal catch, crowd pleasing, western attire, and ability to manage the rope.
- 9. Contestants will be required to have one legal catches on slick horns to advance.-no fishing.
- 10. Contestants who catch will rope in the Finals for the Main Awards on Sunday. **Please confirm with volunteer if able to return on Sunday **
- 11. JUDGES' DECISION WILL BE FINAL NO EXCEPTIONS
